Students of this department who have not obtained the Japanese Language Proficiency Test N2 certificate before graduation must take the make-up examination organized by the department, and those who fail to pass must take the "Japanese License Counseling" course in summer. 8. Students of this department or the teaching content is basic Japanese. 9. The graduation credits of F.5 Education System students are required to increase at least 12 credits. 10. For "Graduation Project Internship (I)" and "Graduation Project Internship (Part II)", students can choose to produce a graduation project or off-campus internship. 11.
